Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that I have been notified by the concerned assignee that it approves the delegation of code 882 34 for ENUM in accordance with the attached request.

This ENUM delegation is for the exclusive purpose of providing mobile telephony services to the few areas of Antarctica where scientists live. These numbering resources are to be used exclusively to provide services to subscribers in those geographic areas of Antarctica. The ENUM delegation is for MMS use which is a mobile service.

This approval is subject to review and modification by Study Group 2, in particular with respect to the choice of Tier 1 registry for the shared code 882.

This approval is based on the understanding that all administrative entities, including DNS administrators, will adhere to all the applicable tenets of all pertinent ITU Recommendations, e.g. E.164, E.164.1, E.190 and E.195, with regard to the inclusion of the E.164 resource information in the DNS.

Please also note that the concerned Member State may at any time revoke its approval and request that TSB file an objection to the delegation.
